## **Recreational Fires**

Recreational fires are permitted within the city limits as long as there is not a Fire Ban in place. They can take place at any time during the day and do not require an open a burning permit. Recreational fires must meet the following requirements:

1. An area of no more than a three (3) foot diameter circle (measured from the inside of the fire ring or border) completely surrounded by noncombustible and non-smoke or odor producing material .
2. Recreation fire sites shall not be located closer than twenty (20) feet of a structure or fence.
